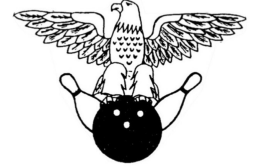

General Rules:

All entries in this tournament must be made in accordance with U.S.B.C. Rules. All entrants must be sanctioned through a league of the Mid-Hudson USBC Association prior to the start of the tournament. No sanctions will be made through the tournament and/or by the tournament director.

Any individual entered in this tournament failing to appear on the lanes when scheduled to bowl, shall forfeit the entry unless the Tournament Manager finds sufficient reason for granting postponement.

Any individual arriving late shall begin play with the score to count from the frame then being bowled.

It is agreed, that in the event that circumstances beyond control of the Mid-Hudson USBC. shall arise before or during the scheduled tournament thereby causing the cancellation or suspension of the tournament in part or in its entirety, the Mid-Hudson USBC shall make payment of the prorated prize list based on the number of individuals who have bowled up to the time of suspension or cancellation of the tournament plus the return of the complete entry fees to those individuals who have not

Lane Assignment:

Lanes will be assigned by the Tournament Committee after closing date and prior to the start of the tournament

HANDICAP:

A handicap based on 100% of the difference between each bowlers highest U.S.B.C. league average for the 2008-2009 winter season. If at the opening of this tournament, March 21, 2010, a bowler's average is 10 pins or more higher than their 2008-2009 average for 21 or more games, it must be reported to the Tournament Management and they will be handicapped on that average.

Bowlers with no previous (2008-2009) winter season average will use their highest current Mid-Hudson U.S.B.C. league average for 21 or more games as of March 1, 2009. Must include League name and bowling center to confirm average.

PRIZES:

There shall be cash prizes for the high scores, net and handicap. A bowler can only cash once.
